Join us Wednesday, February 23rd for a Math Game Night sponsored by Title 1. Meet at 6:00 pm in the school gym.

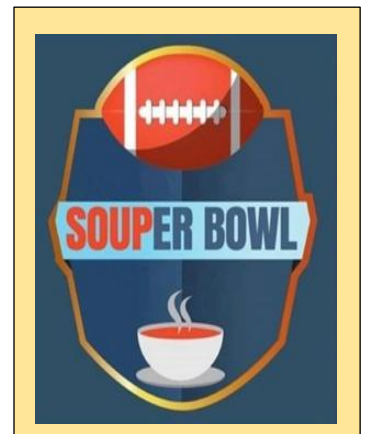
Starting Monday, January 31, for two weeks, Osmond Elementary and Afton Elementary will be going head-to-head in our first **"Soup"er Bowl** competition.
