They realize, and studies show, that everyone benefits from communication between parents and the school. Thank you for taking time out of your busy schedules to visit with your student's teachers.

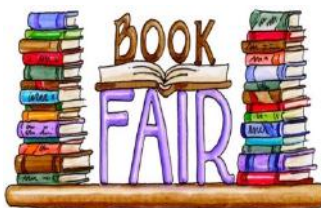
Our Scholastic Book Fair will be open Oct 31st – Nov 3rd during school hours and during the evenings of Parent Teacher Conferences.

Osmond Elementary Service Fundraiser

We are excited about the new fundraiser this year. It gives the students an opportunity to commit to doing service projects or good deeds, then share what they are doing with friends and family through their individual website. In return, family and friends can donate money to support their cause and efforts. All the funds will go towards paying for the two winter ski trips.

Getting Started:

Below you will find step by step instructions to register your student and help them customize their website. There is not a specific number of service projects they have to commit to, but the more effort they show, the more people will want to reward their efforts.

Please encourage your student to select projects that require some effort, creativity, and make a difference in our community. Some suggestions include: picking up trash on a stretch of road or park, visiting a care center and playing games or reading with the elderly, doing yard work for a neighbor in need, writing thank you notes for first responders, etc. The options are limitless, and we are excited to see what you come up with!

Sharing your student's website:

Once your student has completed their website you can share the link by copying it and emailing or texting it to friends and family, or by posting it on social media. Then they can donate to fund your skiing experience this year. Family and friends are not purchasing individual services or deeds but are instead donating and then the student is pledging to do the various items they have listed. Parents, we are asking for your help in making sure the student follows through. If you or family and friends would prefer to pay cash or check, and not pay through the website, you are welcome to do so. Please write checks to Osmond Elementary and make sure you note the student(s) that it should be credited to. We are asking each student to earn a minimum of \$50.

Gift Card Rewards:

Osmond will be giving away two \$25 Amazon gift cards for each grade level. One will be for the student in that grade level that comes up with the most creative and meaningful service project ideas, and the other will go to the student in that grade level that earned the largest amount in donations.



Student Registration Instructions



- Please visit: <https://go.rallyup.com/osmond>
- Click the "sign up" button just under the picture
- Click "sign up" again and then click "add to cart" to register student
- Click "check out now"
- Register your student by entering the following information:
 - Student's first and last name
 - You have the option to "keep my last name private" if you would like to do so.
 - If you have more than one student at the school, you can create separate account for each **OR** you can put all names on one.
 - For example, on the first name put: Alex & Nora and then the last name. This makes it so that grandparents or others only need to do one charge to support all of the students.
 - Guardian's email address
 - Fundraising goal (minimum of \$50/student. Any extra funds brought in will go towards ski trips for students in need)
 - If desired, personalize the link with your student's name at the end.
- Click "save" and then click "next" at the bottom of the page
- Enter your information for the registration receipt.
 - You will then see "Select your registration preferences (optional)" Please ignore the optional option and instead mark the Box, then create a password. It will save you steps in the long run!
 - Click "next", then have to "submit"
- You will then be brought to the "Fundraising Page"
 - There is a box at the bottom that says, "select your notification preferences". You can leave that checked or uncheck it based on if you would like to receive notifications or not.
 - Just above the notification preferences you will see "My Account", click there.
- Click on "My Members" then click on your student's name
- Click "view fundraising page"
- Customize services by clicking on the text (please do not change anything else).
- After adding the service ideas, you are ready to share your student's link with family and friends. You will see where you can share it through FB, twitter, or email the link out. Share the link and you are ready to begin!
