MAKE 40 DEPOSITS AND EARN \$25.00

How do I sign up?

- Open an account at any or all local banks. (Students may have an account at more than one bank if they wish). If your student already has a savings account at a local bank you do not need to open another account.

How does the program work?

- 40 deposits are required to earn the \$25.00. Each time your student makes a deposit, they will earn a Bank Buck. **These Bank Bucks will be turned into your bank for the grand prize of \$25.00. You must have all 40 Bank Bucks to redeem the grand prize!**
- The school will provide 32 banking days. At these banking days, your student can make their deposit at the school. The PTO will be responsible for getting the deposits to the local banks. Banking days at Osmond will be on Tuesdays, starting September 24th through May 20th.
- Students will be responsible for making the other 8 deposits at their banks to reach the goal of 40 deposits. Students can make additional deposits at the bank if they miss a school banking day.
- The minimum deposit will be \$1.00.
- Students will learn how to complete a deposit slip with their name and account number and make the deposit into their bank account. Please encourage your child to memorize their bank account number.

Please stop by the local banks listed below if you have any questions or want to open a savings account for your student. This is a great program to help teach our children to how save for their future.



Please return this page signed to Osmond Elementary. We will keep their account numbers safe and they can refer to them each week when filling out deposit slips. This form must be signed for your child to participate in the banking program at Osmond Elementary.
