Ski Trip Information ...



- Buses will leave Osmond at approximately 8 am. Please make sure your student isn't tardy that day.
- Make sure your student dresses properly socks, snow pants, hats that cover the ears, warm mittens, or gloves (not cloth), and a warm coat.
- Students should only be in the lodge for eating, using the restroom, or if they have an injury.
- Don't forget a lunch & water! If your student ordered a sack lunch from school, they can pick it up that morning. Students can also purchase food at Pine Creek's snack bar or bring a lunch from home. We suggest that students bring extra food to snack on. All the fun makes them hungry!
