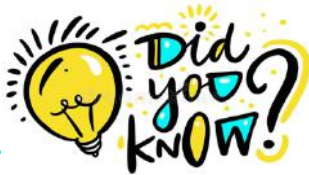
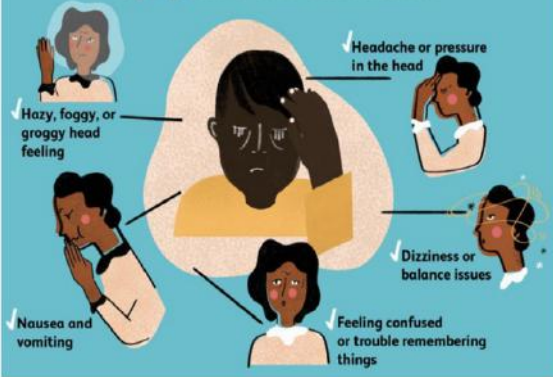
- Buses will leave Osmond at approximately 8 am. Please make sure your student isn't tardy that day.
- Make sure your student dresses properly – socks, snow pants, hats that cover the ears, warm mittens, or gloves (not cloth), and a warm coat.
