CHARACTER EDUCATION

In November, Osmond students will continue to learn more about their ANS (autonomic nervous system) and how it helps keep them safe by always scanning their environments for possible threats. If the ANS senses danger, then their bodies automatically go in "fight, flight, or freeze." This can happen whether it is real danger, or takes the form of social or emotional threats. Worry, anxiety, self-doubt, or anger can result. Students will continue to learn strategies for how to control these and other strong emotions. By understanding what's happening in their bodies and learning self-regulation strategies, students can feel empowered and realize they have more control than they may have realized.



November is National Diabetes Awareness Month.



Do you know the difference between Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes?

Type 1 Diabetes is an autoimmune disease. The immune system mistakes the insulin-producing cells in the pancreas as "invaders" and attacks them. Once this happens, the cells can no longer produce insulin and the person must depend on insulin injections or an insulin pump to stay alive. Currently, there is no cure for Type 1 diabetes.

Type 2 Diabetes is a metabolic condition. It's when the body doesn't produce enough insulin or becomes resistant to it. The condition can sometimes be controlled with proper diet and exercise, or a drug to enhance sensitivity to the body's insulin production. More than 50% of Type 2 diabetes can be prevented!
