5TH GRADE WILL GO TO PINE CREEK ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 20TH & THURSDAY, JANUARY 22ND



4TH GRADE WILL GO TO PINE CREEK ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 27TH & TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 3RD

- If you haven't filled out the online ski form, we ask that you do so as soon as possible through the following link: <https://bit.ly/oes2026ski> All students attending the ski trips (even those who will be using their own equipment) are required to have a form completed.**
- Buses will leave Osmond at approximately 8 am. Please make sure your student isn't tardy that day.**
- NEW THIS YEAR – helmets will be mandatory for all students when skiing. Helmets will be provided by the school, or students are welcome to bring their own if they have one.**
- Make sure your student is dressed properly – socks, snow pants, warm mittens, or gloves (not cloth), and a warm coat. Students are welcome to wear a neck gator or ski mask to go under the helmet. Please note most stocking caps will not fit under the ski helmets.**
- Students should only be in the lodge for eating, using the restroom, or if they have an injury.**
- Don't forget a lunch & water! If your student ordered a sack lunch from school, they can pick it up that morning. Students can also purchase food at Pine Creek's snack bar or bring a lunch from home. We suggest that students bring extra food to snack on. All the fun makes them hungry!**
- Students will not be dropped off at their home. They can be picked up at Osmond at approximately 4 pm or the District Office at approximately 4:15 pm. Students can walk home from the District office or be picked up there. Please make a plan with your student ahead of time so they know where they will be picked up.**
