# “Liberty Hall” is coming to Osmond Elementary



In commemoration of the 250th anniversary of our great nation, Osmond Elementary is excited to announce the creation of the new **Liberty Learning Hall** coming this spring. This project is becoming a reality through a committee of teachers and parents working together. This inspiring addition will transform one of our hallways into an engaging, educational tribute to America's story of freedom. The centerpiece will be a beautifully framed and eye-catching **Liberty Learning Wall**, which represents our nation's journey in three sections: “A New Vision,” “The War Years,” and “A More Perfect Union.” Each featured document and image includes an interactive QR code that connects students and visitors to short video clips and curriculum resources that bring history to life. On the opposite side of the hall, visitors will see a flag that was flown over the U.S. Capitol Building, a large image of George Washington at Valley Forge, and we will be honoring Star Valley students who went on to serve our country with a special “Honor Wall.” We will be reaching out to parents and community members to help us gather names and photos for this meaningful tribute.

The Liberty Learning Wall is being funded through the America 250 Grant, which we were recently awarded, and we will be seeking additional donations to complete the Liberty Hall. A permanent “The Gift” plaque will recognize our “Minute Men” - individuals who contribute \$20 to help make this vision a reality. More information on how to donate and participate will be shared soon. This permanent installation will serve as a powerful teaching tool, a source of pride for our students, and a lasting legacy for generations of Osmond Elementary families to enjoy.


